






### **Advanced Video Analytics**

<u>Restream</u> is a browser-based multistreaming platform that lets you create engaging and professional live videos and stream them to multiple destinations simultaneously. Stream to Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, YouTube, Twitch or any live video service that accepts RTMP streaming. With Restream, you can also broadcast live streams to your website and upload pre-recorded videos to stream them live.
